

## **Election method for CE and Forming of LegCo – 2012**

Our LegCo representative, Patrick Lau, wishes to find out the views of members of the professional institutes under the Architects, Surveyors and Town Planners Functional Constituency regarding the electoral method for CE and forming of LegCo in 2012. The Government's consultation document can be viewed at [www.cmad-cd2012.gov.hk](http://www.cmad-cd2012.gov.hk).

In accordance with NPCSC's decision that HK may elect its CE by universal suffrage by 2017 and all LegCo members by 2020, and that under the principle of gradual and orderly progress, election method may be made for the election of CE and forming of LegCo in 2012. To attain election of CE by universal suffrage in 2017 the current HKSAR's job is to further democratize the electoral system for 2012 so as to pave the way for universal suffrage in 2017.

For members' quick reference the CE Election Committee is composed of 4 sectors : 1- Industrial, commercial and financial, 2- The professions, 3- Labor, social services, religious, and others; 4- Members of LegCo, Heung Yee Kok, members of NPC and DCs. 200 representatives from each sector. The total registered voters for the 4 sectors as of 2009 is 231,140 including 214,554 individuals and 16,586 bodies. Members may refer to the consultation document for details.

Members may express their views by filling the attached questionnaire which are taken out of the consultation document. Members are not required to enter the membership number as stated in the consultation document that all personal data are submitted on voluntary basis.
